DETENTION ORDER


On September 13, 2012, the above-named Defendant, represented by counsel, appeared before the Magistrate Court for a probable cause and detention hearing. The Court having heard evidence from the Government and the Defendant, this Court finds probable cause that Mr. Brown would be a flight risk and a danger to the safety of the community if released from custody during the pendency of this action. Mr. Brown is a citizen of the United States of America. Mr. Brown is charged by a criminal complaint of threatening to harm an agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, as well as attempting to disclose personal information about the F.B.I agent on the internet. The Government has filed a motion for detention alleging Mr. Brown is a risk of flight and a danger to the safety of the community. This Court does find probable cause that Mr. Brown committed the crimes as alleged in the complaint. The Court further finds by clear and convincing evidence that Mr. Brown is a danger to the safety of the community and a risk of flight. This Court also finds that there are no conditions or combinations of conditions

that would protect the safety of the community and assure the appearance of Mr. Brown for future court proceedings. The Court grants the Government's motion for detention.

It is ORDERED that Defendant be, and he is hereby, committed to the custody of the Attorney General and United States Marshal's for confinement in a corrections facility separate, to the extent practicable, from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal, and that Defendant, while being so held, be afforded reasonable opportunity for private consultation with his counsel.

It is further ORDERED that, on an Order of a Court of the United States or at the request of the attorney for the Government, the person in charge of the corrections facility in which Defendant is confined shall deliver Defendant to a United States Marshal for the purpose of an appearance in connection with a court proceedings in the Northern District of Texas.
