
ORDER

Before the court is the Government’s Unopposed Motion to Conditionally Unseal, filed July 16, 2013. After carefully considering the motion and applicable law, the court **grants** the motion.

It is **ordered** that the probable cause and detention hearing conducted on September 13, 2012, in *United States v. Barrett Brown* (Criminal Complaint) 3:12-MJ-405-BF, and any recording or transcription of said recording, are hereby for the limited purpose of the government providing discovery to the defense in the above case.

It is further **ordered** that the items referenced above shall be considered “protected materials” for the purposes of this order, and therefore subject to the conditions and restriction set out in paragraphs 2 through 10 of the Agreed Protective Order issued on June 20, 2013, in 3:12-CR-317-L (Document 66).
